Air beds	Burnable garbage	Remove cables and put out as Non-burnable garbage. Cut the bed into pieces small enough to fit in the designated bag or fold and tie tightly with a sturdy string or wire in a crisscross pattern to prevent unfolding, then put out in the designated bag.
Air conditioner, cooler (indoor unit, outdoor unit)	Not collected	Subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Act. Recycling is mandatory. *See page 6 *Ceiling-mounted air conditioners, ceiling-mounted multi air conditioners, wall-mounted air conditioners, and packaged air conditioners are not subject to the Recycling Act.

Aluminum ladders and stepladders	Non-burnable garbage	Items that do not fit in a single designated bag with the top closed are classified as Oversized Garbage. Oversized Garbage is limited to items under 2.5 m long.

Baby bouncers	Burnable garbage	Items made of metal are Non-burnable garbage. Items that do not fit in a single designated bag with the top closed are classified as Oversized Garbage.

Bamboo screens and reed screens	Burnable garbage	Items that do not fit in a single designated bag with the top closed are classified as Oversized Garbage.

Binoculars and telescopes	Non-burnable garbage	Items that do not fit in a single designated bag with the top closed are classified as Oversized Garbage.

Blankets, sheets, towel blankets	Clothes	Do not place in plastic bags, but tie with a string in a crisscross pattern and put out on Clothes day. Items that are heat-retaining or insulated or contain cotton or feathers are Burnable garbage. These items are collected as usual on rainy days, but cannot be recycled if they get wet. Do not put them out on a rainy day or when it is expected to rain, and put them out on the next
Blinds	Oversized Garbage	Tie to prevent blinds from coming apart.
Blocks (concrete)	Not collected	Consult the store of purchase, a dealer, or a contractor.
Blood pressure monitors (items containing mercury)	Not collected	Consult the shop of purchase or a dealer. Blood pressure monitors with digital displays are Non-burnable garbage.
Blue tarps	Burnable garbage	See Carpets and Rugs.
Boards (wood or plastic)	Burnable garbage	Cut the item to fit into the designated bag. When taking to the Clean Center, cut to within 80 cm of length and bundle it with a sturdy string or wire.

Bottles(bottles containing pesticides or deleterious substances)	Not collected	Bottles that contain pesticides or deleterious substances are not collected by the city.
Bowling balls	Not collected	Consult the shop of purchase or a dealer.
Branches, trees, bamboo, etc.	Burnable garbage	Branches, trees, and bamboo that grow as plants, not wood or furniture parts. Cut into pieces no larger than 15 cm in diameter and no longer than 80 cm in length, tie together with sturdy string or wire so that the circumference of the bundle is no larger than 1 m, and attach a ¥40 Pruned Twig Disposal Ticket to each bundle. *See page 11 Small branches and trees can also be put out in designated Burnable garbage bags. Each household can put out up to 3 bundles (3 bags) at a time. Have a contractor collect items longer than 80 cm or thicker than 15 cm. *Garbage pruned by a business or that were generated by a business are not collected by the city.

Calendars	Other printed materials	Tie with string and put out on Miscellaneous Paper day. Small pieces can be placed in a paper bag then tied. Remove metal fittings and put them with Non-burnable garbage.
Cameras (including video cameras)	Non-burnable garbage	Bring battery packs at retailers or other cooperating store locations.
Camping tents	Burnable garbage	Fold the sheet, then tie tightly with a sturdy string or wire in a crisscross pattern to prevent unfolding, then put out in the designated bag or cut into a size that will fit into the designated bag. Metal parts can be disposed of as if they fit in the designated bag. Items that do not fit in a single designated bag with the top closed are classified as Oversized Garbage.
Cans (for food and beverages)	Glass Bottles,Cans, Plastic(PET)Bottles	Limited to Cans for food and beverages. Remove the cap and wash the inside. Dispose of plastic caps as Plastic containers and wrappings. Dispose of metal caps as Non-burnable garbage.
Cans (for paint)	Non-burnable garbage	Items with content still inside are not collected by the city. Absorb small amounts of paint with paper or cloth and dispose of as Burnable garbage, then dispose of the can as Non-burnable garbage. Unused paint cans cannot be disposed of with paint still inside.
Cans(for gasoline)	Non-burnable garbage	Items still containing gasoline are not collected by the city.
Cans(Spray Cans)	Non-burnable garbage	Empty, then drill a hole in a well-ventilated area away from open flames before disposing. *See page 13 *Explosions and fires have occurred in collection vehicles that are thought to have been caused by gas canisters and Spray Cans that did not have hole drilled into them. Empty gas and Spray Cans properly.

Empty gas and Spray Cans properly.
